This is a Wilderness campout; you should bring a tent or a pop-up type camper. There will be portable toilets available at the wilderness campsite.

**Rates:** \$11.00 per night / per person – This is paid directly to The Peace River Campground – Check in at the General Store which is directly in front of the main entrance.

**Canoes:** Canoes have been reserved at the Canoe Outpost – Canoes are to be reserved by tribe and all cash must be turned into the representative from Canoe Outpost Friday late afternoon. A Canoe Sign-up Sheet will be provided for your convenience. The form includes a list of who'll be canoeing, number of back rests along with the exact cash amount that has been collected.
